



Wahoo Swing Mooring Pontoons (SMPs) are a patented, award winning platform design that relates to boat moorings in rivers, lakes and harbors that require a circular area known as "swing moorings."

Wahoo SMPs allow a greater number of vessels to be moored in a given area thereby enhancing the revenue potential of the moorings. Alternatively, they can be employed to reduce the area occupied by a given number of moored vessels for navigational, environmental or planning reasons.

Wahoo SMPs can be used as a permanent installation or, because they can be easily transported and installed can be used as a temporary marina for yacht races, fishing contests or other aquatic events.

Wahoo SMPs vary in size to accommodate vessels of different length and beam and can be used alone or configured in "pods" to berth 4, 8 or more boats in one grouping. The patented design provides for a stable perch whether used alone or with two or more connected together.
